Bicycle Lane (on-street, marked)	Image source: https://qimby.net/image/Rdils	 Dedicated lane for cyclists on the roadway. May have physical elements to separate from motorized traffic.
Advisory Bicycle lane	Image source: https://qimby.net/image/3Mrs	 Marked lane for cyclists. May be used by motorized traffic if necessary.

Bicycle Street	Image source: https://qimby.net/image/47yj	 Cyclists have priority, but motorized traffic is allowed in most cases. Speed limit of 30 km/h.
Farm Road	Image source: https://qimby.net/image/vHd	 Mixed use rural road, mainly for agricultural vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists.
Shared Roadway (30km/h)	Image source: https://qimby.net/image/Ccrs	 Cyclists ride on the carriageway, together with motorized traffic. Speed limit of 30 km/h.
